



Affordable Tax Services

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On your 2021 tax return we are required to report the amount you have received on your third stimulus checks. If you have received it or not, we will need to report what was actually received by you. In some situations, the IRS may have issued stimulus payments to you; however, they may not have been received by you. You can get the information about your stimulus checks by creating an account at www.irs.gov and downloading your transcripts for 2021.

Starting in July IRS started sending checks monthly to those who had children under the age of 17 to tax payers for those did not opt out of receiving the Advance Child Tax Credit (ACTC). These amounts must be reported on the tax return and will lower your child tax credit.

Affordable Tax Service is only responsible for reporting the amounts you actually receive and will report the amounts you provide to us. These amounts must be accurate. If the amounts are not accurate your return will be moved over to the hand processing department and **WILL DELAY YOUR REFUND UP TO OVER A YEAR.** Affordable Tax service will not be held responsible or liable for any delays of your refund or any liabilities related to the numbers you provide to us with regarding these amounts and what you report to us. **Also know that once we submit your return to the IRS there is nothing that we can do to get your refund any faster and will not call the IRS on your behalf until you receive a notice from them.**
